Diocesan Synod

Youth Synod

What is it?	An annual meeting of clergy and lay people from across the diocese	An annual gathering for young people to voice their opinions and concerns regarding the church and the world
What do they do?	Passing an annual budget, information sharing and making important decisions about the church, participate in worship	Youth members write and debate motions, participate in contemporary worship and take part in socials and get to know one another
Who gets to go?	Clergy, elected adults and one elected youth (aged 16-25) from each parish	Up to three youth delegates (ages 13-21 as of January 2009) per parish may be elected or designated
When is it?	November 20 & 21, 2009	Fri, May 1 - Sun, May 3, 2009
Where is it held?	Hamilton Convention Centre	Hosted by a parish – in 2009 by St. Christopher's, Burlington
How many people attend?	Approximately 400 voting delegates	Approximately 120 youth from across the diocese and 50 volunteers



Why would I want to attend Diocesan Synod?

- I care about the Anglican Church and how it includes and listens to youth.
- I care about my parish and want to speak on their behalf.
- I want to meet other young people from across the diocese.
- I want to know about the issues that are important to our diocesan, Canadian and global church.
- I want to have a say in the diocesan budget.
